

Regulations for rewarding Indian Masters Students of the Department of Electronic Engineering at the National Ilan University

Passed during the seventh departmental meeting of the 2019–2020 academic year on May 27, 2020

- Article 1. To reward Indian Masters students for their consistent academic diligence during the study period, as well as to promote diversity and internationalism in the department, the Electronic Engineering Department of the National Ilan University (hereinafter called the Department) has established the “Regulations for rewarding Indian Masters Students of the Department of Electronic Engineering at the National Ilan University” (hereinafter referred to as the “Regulations”).
- Article 2. These regulations are applicable to Indian Masters students enrolled in the Department during the 2019–2020 academic year or thereafter.
- Article 3. Students satisfying the criteria in (2) can apply for financial aid (worth NT\$5,000) by submitting the following documents to the Department: (i) A photocopy of student ID with the registration stamp of the current semester, (ii) supporting documents to prove the applicant’s fulfillment of the criteria mentioned in (2), and (iii) a completed copy of the financial aid application form. Once approved, the financial aid is granted for a total of four semesters.
- Article 4. The scholarships (financial aid) in these regulations will be financed by the “Donations from various sectors - Designated use: Department of Electronics, Scholarships for Masters Students from India (Year F212-1)” of the Department. The scholarships will no longer be provided once the fund is exhausted.
- Article 5. Any matter not mentioned in these regulations is to be resolved pursuant to relevant regulations of the National Ilan University
- Article 6. These regulations shall be promulgated and enforced upon approval at the Departmental Meeting.
